- In 1976 Prado Regional Park opened and it included two 18-hole golf courses.
- The courses were initially operated by a group of doctors who leased the property.
- Both Chino Creek and Butterfield were designed by Harry and David Rainville.
- The location was once a stagecoach stop called “Butterfield Stage”.
- In 2023 a new sublease for the golf course was aquired by El Prado Development, LLC.
